Communications Research Update

In the last edition of Pensioner Talk, we advised that the Fund was conducting a Communication Research Project. In this regard an independent company, Devnomics, was appointed to conduct research to understand the communication needs of you, our pensioners, and our active members.

To date, Devnomics has conducted interviews and focus group meetings with pensioners at pensioner functions in June and July and with in-service members of the Fund. In areas where pensioner functions were not held, the Devnomics team invited pensioners to attend focus groups to discuss pensioner communication needs.

COMPLETION OF QUESTIONNAIRE

Another step in the communications research is the completion of a pensioner questionnaire. The questionnaire is enclosed with this newsletter, together with a pre-addressed, post-free envelope. Please take some time to complete the questionnaire and post it in the envelope provided by 15 October 2013. You will note that the post-free envelope is addressed to Devnomics in Cape Town. This is to ensure that the questionnaires reach Devnomics directly and your responses can be independently captured by Devnomics.

As you consider your medical aid options for 2014, remember that when the Fund makes your medical aid and other deductions from your pension, you must ensure that your deductions do not exceed the pension which you receive.

Investment Administration and Investment Management System Replacement

In 2012, the Fund embarked on an Information Technology (IT) Roadmap Project to modernise the Fund's IT and administration systems in order to optimise efficiencies around the way the Fund operates.

One of the major projects that took place in 2012 was the replacement of the Fund administration systems in the Retirement Fund Operations Department and the Payroll Department. The Fund has continued with other initiatives on the IT Roadmap, some of which include Business Intelligence projects and the modernisation of our technologies.

As part of the IT Roadmap, the Fund has undertaken to replace the Investment Administration and Management system, which is utilised by the Fund's Investment Administration Department and the Investment Management Unit (IMU).

Maitland Group South Africa has been appointed to provide the Fund with the new investment administration and management platform.

Through this initiative, the Investment Administration Department, the Investment Management Unit and the Risk and Compliance Department will be able to automate many transactions, processes and functions which are currently performed on a manual basis. They will also be able to increase efficiencies, as the system will also allow

for the compilation of most of the reports produced by the three areas to be compiled on a single platform.

The IMU is responsible for the investment of the Fund's assets in order to provide returns to provide for the benefits of members, pensioners and beneficiaries in terms of the Rules of the Fund. The Investment Administration Department is a sub-department of the Finance Department that is responsible for the administration of the investments which are managed by the IMU.

This project will not have any impact on members and pensioners as it concerns the replacement of the internal investment administration and management platform.

Changes to the Eskom Voluntary Funeral Scheme

With effect from 1 July 2013, the Eskom Group Voluntary Funeral Scheme to Sanlam was moved to Sanlam. Sanlam had previously underwritten the scheme for eight years and is the second largest insurer in South Africa. The Compulsory Death Benefit claim administration was also moved to Sanlam with effect from 1 July 2013. Pensioners now have one point of contact for all funeral claims and policy servicing needs.

WHAT CHANGES COME WITH THE MOVE TO SANLAM?

The change to Sanlam results in an immediate enhancement of benefits to the Voluntary Funeral scheme by up to 10% as well as the introduction of a R500 airtime voucher on any network for the nominated beneficiary on the death of the Principal Life Assured. The Repatriation and Medical Assistance Benefits continue as before. Cover for dependents is now worldwide but will still be paid in South Africa and in South African currency. Another important benefit is that the paid-up benefit provides for the continuation of benefits for your spouse in the event of your death at no additional premium. Most importantly, all these enhancements come at no additional cost.

A dedicated team at Sanlam has been allocated to the Eskom scheme to ensure that you as a member have direct communication channels to the scheme administrator. Over the next few weeks, Sanlam will contact all members of the funeral scheme to explain the changes and enhancements and we implore all members to make use of this opportunity to ask questions and deal with any concerns that you may have. Sanlam has also undertaken to improve contact with the pensioners of the Fund through regular newsletters and information sessions.

Sanlam will take over the entry dates and waiting periods applicable to the previous scheme so that members are not prejudiced by the changes. The previous underwriter remains legally responsible for voluntary funeral claims before 1 July 2013. However, in the interest of assisting pensioners, Sanlam will assist with all claims. This means that all claims, even claims prior to 1 July 2013, may be submitted to Sanlam.

Tax certificates for tax year ending 28 February 2013

The Fund recently issued pensioners with tax certificates for the tax year ending 28 February 2013. Due to the Fund's change of the administration system during the tax year, the Fund had to issue pensioners with two tax certificates; one from the old system and one from the new system. In total, these two certificates reflect all your income tax details for the year and they should both be used for completing the tax return for the year.

There is a tax certificate for the period 01 March 2012 to 30 June 2012, and a tax certificate for the period 01 July 2012 to 28 February 2013. Please note that the issuing of two certificates is only applicable to the 2013 tax year. From 2014 onwards, the Fund will revert back to issuing only one tax certificate, as per the previous norm.

Pensioners who received IT3 A or IT3 B forms from SARS do not need to file their returns with SARS as they earn less than the set threshold.

The Fund would like to thank all pensioners for their patience with this procedure and apologise for any inconvenience caused.

2013/2014 Evidence of Survival Season Begins

It is that time of the year again when the Fund sends out Evidence of Survival (EOS) forms for pensioners to complete. The 2013/2014 EOS forms were posted with the September pay slips.

The purpose of the EOS form is to verify your existence. By completing the EOS form you provide proof of your existence and confirm that the Fund should continue paying your monthly pension.

Please make sure that your EOS form is accurately completed, certified by a Commissioner of Oaths and returned to the Fund before 11 April 2014. If the Fund does not receive your EOS form by this date, the payment of your pension will be suspended from May 2014 until the Fund receives your form.

Pensioners will be sent reminders for submission, as well as confirmations of receipt of the forms through the pension pay slips and by SMS.



WIDOWS, WIDOWERS AND GUARDIANS WITH MINOR CHILDREN, TAKE NOTE:

Widows, widowers and guardians with minor children in receipt of a pension, as well as disabled children in receipt of a lifelong pension, please take note of the following:

- Each widow/widower and child in the household who receives a pension will receive their own individual EOS form to be completed, certified and returned to the Fund; and
- In the case of a minor child or a disabled child, the guardian must complete and sign the form on behalf of the minor or disabled child.

Benefits payable in the event of a pensioner passing away ...

In case of the death of a pensioner, a once-off death benefit lump sum of R3000 is payable to the beneficiaries. This may be a remaining spouse and/or eligible children and other dependants, if any.

In addition to the once-off lump sum as above, the Fund will also allocate a monthly pension to qualifying beneficiaries, as follows:

If a pensioner dies and is survived by a spouse and/or eligible children, the Fund will calculate a monthly pension based on the original value of the deceased pensioner's annual pension at retirement plus all increases the deceased pensioner had received while on retirement.

The surviving spouse will receive 60% of the recalculated pension, plus a further 30% for one eligible child or 40% for two or more eligible children, until the children reach the age of 21 years. The spouse's pension is payable for life, even

if the spouse remarries. Only children under 21 years are eligible to receive a pension. In the event where a deceased pensioner leaves more than one legal spouse, the monthly pension would be divided amongst the qualifying spouses.

In the event where the deceased pensioner did not have a surviving spouse, but is survived by one eligible child, the child will receive 60% of the recalculated monthly pension until age 21 years.

If a pensioner is survived by two or more eligible children and no spouse, the children will receive 100% of the recalculated monthly pension until they turn 21 years. When there is only one child remaining under age 21 years, the pension will be adjusted to 60% of the recalculated monthly pension until that last child turns 21 years.

Pensioners with joint bank accounts take note:

When a pensioner passes away and

there was a joint bank account with the spouse, the spouse will be required to open a separate bank account in his/her own name to enable the Fund to pay the monthly pension to the correct beneficiary. The deceased pensioner's bank account will be closed by the bank and no transaction will be made into that account.

You must notify the Fund of any bank detail updates before payroll closing dates, which are marked on the Eskom Pension and Provident Fund pensioner calendar.

How to advise the Fund of any change of banking details

Pensioners must advise the Fund in writing, by means of an original letter of a change in banking details. This letter must be accompanied by an originally certified copy of your Identity Document or passport; and an originally certified and stamped bank statement which shows your new banking details.
